CLEP (Non-traditional/Collegiate) Credit Granting Policies at Marian University – Residency policies

- Marian requires that the last 30 hours of credit toward a bachelor degree or last 15 hours toward an associate degree be graded classroom/online credit (not test out or proficiency credits).
- A student who receives CLEP credits during this time are still required to fulfill their last thirty/fifteen credits at Marian University, thus may place their total degree credits required at or over the minimum required for the degree. Check with the associate registrar if you are unsure if you are in your last 30 hours/15 hours toward your bachelor or associate degree and for any other policy credits regarding credit for CLEP at Marian.
- <u>A maximum of 30 CLEP credits</u> may be applied toward a bachelor degree. <u>A maximum of 15 CLEP</u> credits may be applied toward an associate's degree.
